

## Required Documents for 3+2 Bachelor-Master Fast Track Program

- MCUT application form and ID Photo
- Autobiography and Curriculum Vitae
- Study Plan
- International English Test Score Report (TOEIC, IELTS or TOEFL) \*At Least CEFR B1 Level
- Photo page of passport and Student ID
- Official certificate of enrollment issued by home university
- Official transcript of records listing all courses taken so far
- Two recommendation letters from professors at home university
- Copy of Financial Statement with min. USD 3,000 in account (Subject to MOE Taiwan regulation)

- Application deadline : Fall semester Jan 1 April 30
- All of the documents need to **send by the coordinator** of the home university. (IRO IRO application process)
